**This costing does not include crew transport, getting to the regattas  
This will be organized by the Rowers themselves and Coaches with payment to drivers**

With the estimated cost of regattas and training camps for rowers for the season being \$1725 the committee is suggesting that you consider making automatic payments to the club account. This will spread the load for rowers and parents and will assist the club with planning and paying for these events.

The following are some examples of automatic payments you may want to consider between now and February 2010 to

- pay the estimated costs of 1725:
- 5 x monthly payments of \$345.00
- 10 X fortnightly payments of \$172.50
- 20 x weekly payments \$86.25

### **Procedures for collection of regatta/training camp fees**

At the meeting held on 20 August 2009 the Petone Rowing Club Committee discussed the need collect all money for travel to regattas and training camps prior to any travel being undertaken. Chasing up outstanding money had been far too time-consuming in recent years. Coaches and administrators need to spend their valuable time on coaching and record keeping. Chasing outstanding money is not good use of their time. The club has suffered financially and this is unfair on those members who do pay on time.

After considerable discussion the committee decided:

1. **All money for travel to regattas and training camps must be paid two weeks prior to travel. Rowers who have not paid will not be permitted to travel.**
2. **Payments can be made by:**
  - either direct credit to the Club's bank account (National Bank 06-0507-0112335-25) (giving as much detail as possible- at Minimum "rowers name" but if possible also brief description, e.g. "Training camp", "Regatta fees" or "Jury Cup", or
  - By cash or cheque to Viv Haar or Dave Pullar, who will provide receipts showing details of what the payment is for? **[Rowers must ensure they receive a receipt – (It will not be good enough to say we paid "Joe Bloggs" \$300.00 sometime in June without receiving a receipt.)]**
3. *These are indicative costs only and actual costs for each trip will be advised closer to each trip. The amount payable will be the cost advised closer to the trip not the indicative cost on the spreadsheet.*
4. *The charge for each rower, for each trip will cover the rower's accommodation, meals as stated and a share of the transport cost of boats and equipment, and a share of the costs for coaches and responsible parents (if required).*
5. *If travel for the trip is via private cars or vans provided by rowers or parents with full licences, rowers using those vehicles will be expected to pay a share of petrol costs for use of that vehicle. Rowers are to pay cash directly to the driver.*
6. *Following problems with van hire over recent years the Club is unlikely to arrange vans for travel this season.*
7. *Once Greg and Viv have agreed the cost for each trip, (as early as possible) They will advise Dave Pullar the details of the trip including a breakdown of cost/charge, for each rower, and each Coxswain (if less than the charge for rowers), and a list of the rowers who are travelling and who are to be charged. Dave will add that charge to each rower's spreadsheet and issue a group email and text advising the cost for each rower/coxswain.*
8. *Dave Pullar or Viv will collect any cash or cheques from Rowers on a Thursday evening at the Club house and issue receipts. Any money collected will be banked into the Club's account the following day. Dave will send a group txt and email out to Rowers reminding them when he will be at the Clubhouse with a receipt book to collect money.*
